These florilegia of sentences and anecdotes attributed to Greek philosophers have been adapted from the Greek collections into several oriental languages. A compilation of this genre (*Քանք Իմաստասիրաց*) has also been noted to exist in Armenian but it has neither been published nor studied extensively. Van Esbroeck points to the large number of ancient philosophers quoted and to the admixture of Christian elements in the sentences (p. 18). Khosroev briefly presents one of the manuscripts which contains the collection.
